



Unit 6, Week 3

Weekly Materials

- *Between the Lions* alphabet chart
- blocks (wooden, grid, bristle, etc.)
- blue construction paper
- boxes
- building materials (clay, craft sticks, flattened cardboard boxes, paper cups, paper towel rolls, pattern blocks, small pieces of wood, tin foil, etc.)
- chalk
- chairs (one per child)
- chart paper
- circles or squares of paper with a different, colorful, alphabet letter written on each (one per child)

- measuring tools (measuring tape, ruler, etc.)

Unit 6, Week 3 (CONTINUED)

- mural paper cut into sections large enough to trace a child (one for each child)
- name cards
- old magazines
- paired toys (dolls and dollhouses, plastic people and toy cars, etc.)
- paper
- paper fasteners
- pen
- picture book of bridges (such as *Bridges are to Cross* by Philemon Sturges)
- pictures of a fox, an ax, an ox
- pictures of bridges
- play tools (including a hammer)
- scissors
- sentence chart
- sentence strips (cut into word cards)
- stiff paper or manila folders cut into 18" strips, about 2" wide
- stuffed animals (one for each child)
- tape (masking or duct)
- toy cars (one for each child)
- versions of *The Three Little Pigs* book children have been reading: *The Three Little Javelinas* (book,) the class version "Our Three Little Pigs," etc.
- word cards *x-ray*, *house*, *build*, *tool* (2 copies of each)

Alphabet Under Construction by Denise Fleming

A mouse busily constructs each letter of the alphabet: air-brushing the "A," buttoning the "B," and so on, working his way right through to "Z."

Tell the Truth, B. B. Wolf by Judy Sierra

A fractured fairy tale in which the wolf tells his side of the three pigs' story, but with a spin. He finally confesses and attempts to make amends.
