Unit 7: Watch It Grow Week 3: Still Growing

Dear Families,

This week we are observing and measuring the growth of our plants and comparing our plants to plants outdoors. We are watching a *Between the Lions* show about a little red hen who asks her friends for help to plant wheat and then make bread. When they say no, she does it all herself! We are also reading another version of the tale, *The Little Red Hen* by Paul Galdone. We are learning about the letter “Kk,” the letter sound /k/, and the word *kitchen*.

Here are some things you can do at home with your child:

- When you are out and about, encourage your child to notice, describe, and compare interesting trees and other plants you see. What sizes, shapes, textures, and colors can you help your child find?
- Measure a plant that you have inside or outside your home. How tall is the plant? Continue to track its growth by recording the measurements on a sheet of paper. Talk about how the plant grows week by week.
- Invite your child to help prepare a meal or snack. Talk about all the ways your child is helping you.
